- ⇒ Case management—monitor families weekly to ensure that the families are provided and linked with needed services.
- ⇒ Linkage with substances abuse treatment programs— Referrals for both inpatient and outpatient drug treatment programs.
- ⇒ Counseling—Program provides weekly counseling for adults, children, couples and families both in home and out-of-home.

Community linkage services—Families are referred to a number of community-based services, including: medical services, counseling, drug/alcohol treatment support groups, food pantries, housing, employment training and continuing education programs.
